Built by Jacob Lowe, Sr. between 1810 and 1830, the tavern and stage coach stop was located in the little town of Pandora, Tennessee along old stage coach road in the Cherokee National Forest. The picture is dated around 1898 with Jacob Lowe's descendants still in possession of the place.

Before finding this picture my husband's family had no idea their ancestor was a tavern owner. This one little find opens a whole new area of research and changes perceptions of the Lowe family. What a treasure indeed!
